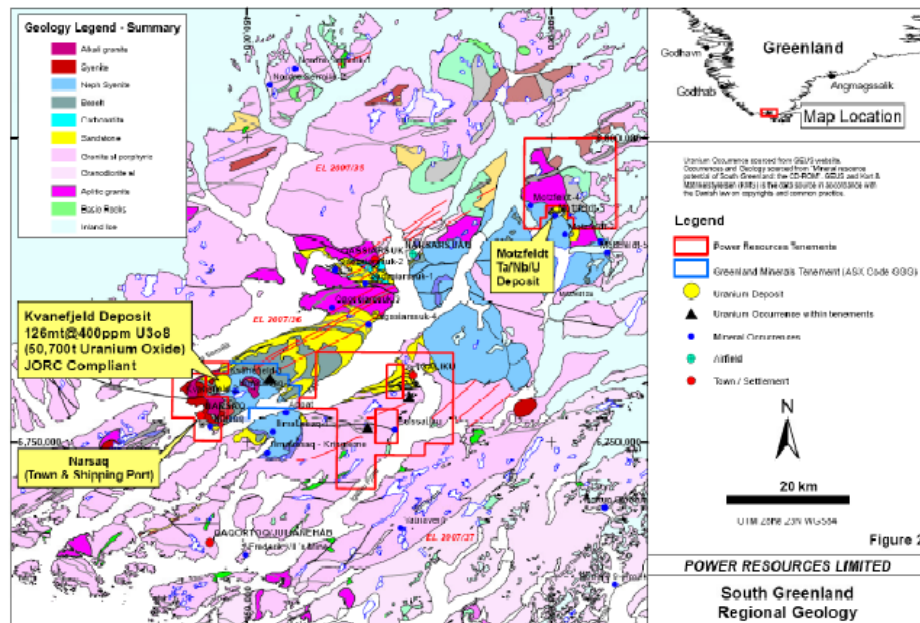
QUARTERLY REPORT FOR THE PERIOD ENDED 30 JUNE 2010

1. EXPLORATION ACTIVITIES

Exploration has continued on the Company's project areas, as detailed below:

1.1 KETILIDIAN PROJECT, SOUTH WEST GREENLAND

The South West Greenland Project is about 20 km southeast and north east of Narsaq Township in southern Greenland. Power has one tenement, 2008/02, in the south western tip of Greenland. The tenement surrounds Kvanefjeld multi element (Rare Earth Elements and Uranium) deposit held by Greenland Minerals and Energy Limited.



Note: eastern two subsections of application 2008/02 (A0484) have been relinquished.

Power has conducted field surveys and seismic evaluations on the project area, during the previous field season. A review of the project area is currently underway and shows strong potential for similar styles of mineralisation to those found at Kvanefjeld.

A number of options for the project are currently being assessed by the Company, including potential joint venture opportunities.

The Company continues its programme of project generation examining various projects in Australia and overseas with a particular focus on uranium and copper.
